ARTICLE 1. CITY ELECTIONS

- 6-101. CONDUCT OF ELECTION. The election of city officials shall be conducted in all respects as provided by the laws of Kansas governing the holding of city elections. (K.S.A. 25-2101 et seq.; Code 2011)
- 6-102. HOURS OF VOTING. At all city elections the polls shall be open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m., unless different hours are set and publicly announced by the county election officer. (K.S.A. 25-2111, 26-206; Code 2011)
- 6-103. COMMENCEMENT OF TERMS OF OFFICE; OATH OF OFFICE. (a) On the first Tuesday in April, 1989, there shall be elected a mayor, city treasurer and eight (8) council members. Each ward shall have two council members who shall be chosen by the qualified electors of their respective wards. The top vote getter in each ward shall be elected for a term of four years. The second highest vote getter in each ward shall be elected for a term of two years. On the first Tuesday in April, 1991, and every two years thereafter, council members shall be elected for a four-year term of office.
- (b) On the first Tuesday in April, 1989, there shall be elected a mayor and city treasurer from said city who shall hold their office for a term of two years. On the first Tuesday in April, 1991, and every two years thereafter, the mayor and city treasurer shall be elected for a two-year term of office.
- (c) Every person elected or appointed to city office, before entering upon the duties of such office, shall take and subscribe an oath or affirmation as specified in K.S.A. 54-106, and amendments thereto, and every such oath or affirmation shall be filed with the city clerk. ARTICLE 2. WARDS

WARDS; DESIGNATION. The City of Marysville, Kansas, shall be divided into four wards, to be numbered Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 3 and Ward 4, with the boundary lines as follows:

(a) Ward 1. Beginning at the most easterly city limits of Marysville on U.S. Highway 36, proceed west to North Twentieth Street, thence north to Carolina Street, thence west to North Eighteenth Street, thence north to Calhoun Street, thence west to North Fifteenth Street, thence north to Laramie Street, thence west to North Thirteenth Street, thence north to Otoe Street, thence west to North Twelfth Street, thence north to Park Place, thence east to North Thirteenth Street, and thence north to city limits.

Ward 1 will be comprised of that territory east of the center lines of North Twelfth, North Thirteenth, North Fifteenth, North Eighteenth and North Twentieth Streets; north of the center lines of U.S. Highway 36 and Calhoun, Carolina, Laramie and Otoe Streets; and south of the center line of Park Place.

(b) Ward 2. Beginning at a point of the north city limits on North Eighth Street, proceed south to North Street, thence West to North Seventh Street, thence south to Alston Street, thence east to North Seventeenth Street, thence north to Calhoun Street, thence west to North Fifteenth Street, thence north to Laramie Street, thence west to North Thirteenth Street, thence north to Otoe Street, thence west to North Twelfth Street, thence north to Park Place, thence east to North Thirteenth Street, and thence north to city limits.

Ward 2 will be comprised of that territory east of the center lines of North Seventh and North Eighth Street; north of the center lines of Alston Street and Park Place; west of the center lines of North Twelfth, North Thirteenth, North Fifteenth and North Seventeenth Street; and south of the center lines of Calhoun, Laramie and Otoe Streets.

(c) Ward 3. Beginning at a point of the north city limits on North Eighth Street, proceed south to North Street, thence west to North Seventh Street, thence south to Alston Street, thence east to North Ninth Street, thence south to Walnut Street, thence east to South Tenth Street, and thence south to the city limits.

Ward 3 will be comprised of that territory west of the center lines of North Seventh, North Eighth, North Ninth, South Ninth, and South Tenth Street; north of the center lines of North Street, and south of the center lines of Alston and Walnut Streets.

(d) Ward 4. Beginning at a point of the south city limits on South Tenth Street, proceed north to Walnut Street, thence west to South Ninth Street, thence north to Alston Street, thence east to North Seventeenth Street, thence north to Calhoun Street, thence east to North Eighteenth Street, thence south to Carolina Street, thence east to North Twentieth Street, thence south to U.S. Highway 36 and thence east to the city limits.

Ward 4 will be comprised of that territory east of the center lines of South Ninth, North Ninth, South Tenth, and North Seventeenth Streets; north of the center line of Walnut Street; west of the center lines of North Twelfth and North

Eighteenth Streets; and south of the center lines of Alston, Calhoun, Carolina Streets and U.S. Highway 36. (Ord. 1620, Sec. 1; C.O. No. 6, Sec. 2; Code 2011)
