

SPECIAL MEETING

City of Marysville, Marysville, Kansas, November 13, 2020

Members of the Governing Body of the City of Marysville were called to order in a special meeting at 5:00 p.m., on the date and at the place noted above with Mayor Barnes opening the meeting. City Clerk Holle and City Administrator St. John were also present.

Council members answering present to roll call were: Pippia, Schroller, Hughes, Price, Behrens and Throm. A quorum was present.

The call, signed by four of six council members present, read as follows:

We, the undersigned councilmembers of the City of Marysville hereby respectfully request that you call a special council meeting of the members of the governing body of said City to be held at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 13, 2020 at City Hall for the following purpose:

Discuss implementing a mask mandate in the City of Marysville.

CM Beikman entered the council chamber at 5:06 pm.

Mayor Barnes reported the newly formed Public Health Group had met and recommended a mask mandate for the City of Marysville. CA St. John said he thought the end date on the mandate should be January 17, 2021 a 60-day period that would include all the upcoming holidays. This mandate would exempt USD #364. Both individuals and businesses could be fined. After discussion by the Council, CM Throm moved to approve Ordinance 1894. **AN ORDINANCE CREATING NEW SECTIONS 11-212 AND 11-214 REQUIRING INDIVIDUALS TO WEAR MASKS OR OTHER FACE COVERINGS IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; REQUIRING BUSINESSES AND ORGANIZATIONS TO REQUIRE ALL EMPLOYEES, CUSTOMERS, VISITORS, MEMBERS, OR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO WEAR A MASK OR OTHER FACE COVERING IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES THEREFORE.** CM Pippia seconded. A roll call vote passed 6-1, with CM Beikman voting no.

At 5:25 p.m., CM Throm moved, CM Behrens seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
