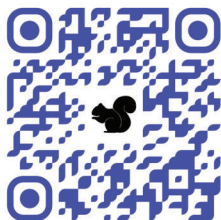

WATER/SEWER UPDATES

DUE DATES FOR WATER/SEWER BILLS

For your convenience we have an after hours drop box located on the south side of the front doors at City hall. As a reminder, bills are due the 22nd of each month.

If the date falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the bill is due the following Monday by 8:00 am.

Water and Sewer Rate updates for 2026

New water and sewer rates are coming to Marysville, effective with the January usage to be billed February 1, 2026.

In 2026, the minimum charge per month for the most common meter size would move to \$73.90, which includes water, sewer and storm water fee ; please refer to the chart for other sizes.

The additional usage charge rate will be calculated at \$0.658 per 100 gallons of water used and at \$0.638 per 100 gallons of sewer usage.

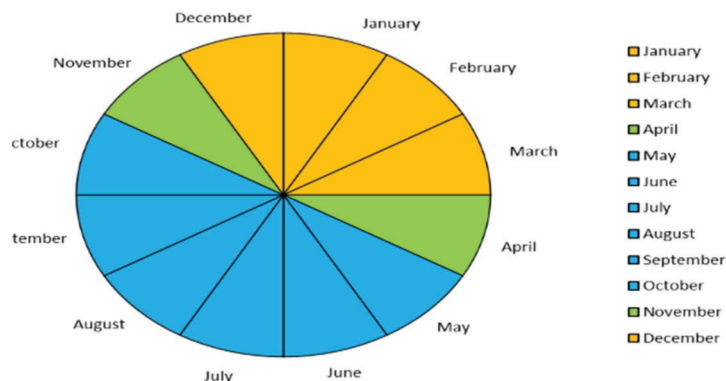

The months of November through April usage will reflect actual usage billing to sewer. From May to October, usage will reflect an average of sewer from December to March.



ADDRESS NUMBERS

Does your home or business have its address number clearly visible from the street? Does your home or business have numbers at all? If you can't see your address number or need to put on numbers, the city has reflective numbers for you to put on your building for FREE! Just stop by City Hall and pick them up during business hours.

Having clear and visible numbers on your building is important as it helps emergency vehicles identify where they need to go. In an emergency, every second counts! Having identifiable address helps cut response time.

2026 Register/Renewal Time

Anyone who wants to register/renew their UTV's or MUT's for 2026 need to stop in at City Hall. We have a copy of the ordinance and brochure so you have all the information needed to get tagged.



BRUSH DUMP

Our city brush dump is open from 9 am until dark 7 days a week.

We do ask that if you are using our dump to please be aware that it is for grass clippings, limbs, tree stumps, etc. We also ask that when you bring these items to the dump that you sort them and place them in the appropriate area for such items. We do not take landscaping items, construction products such as wood, concrete, bricks, etc. or any other household items.

If you have any questions please call City Hall, Monday thru Friday at 785-562-5331. Your attention to our request is greatly appreciated and helps us be able to have it open year round without supervision.
