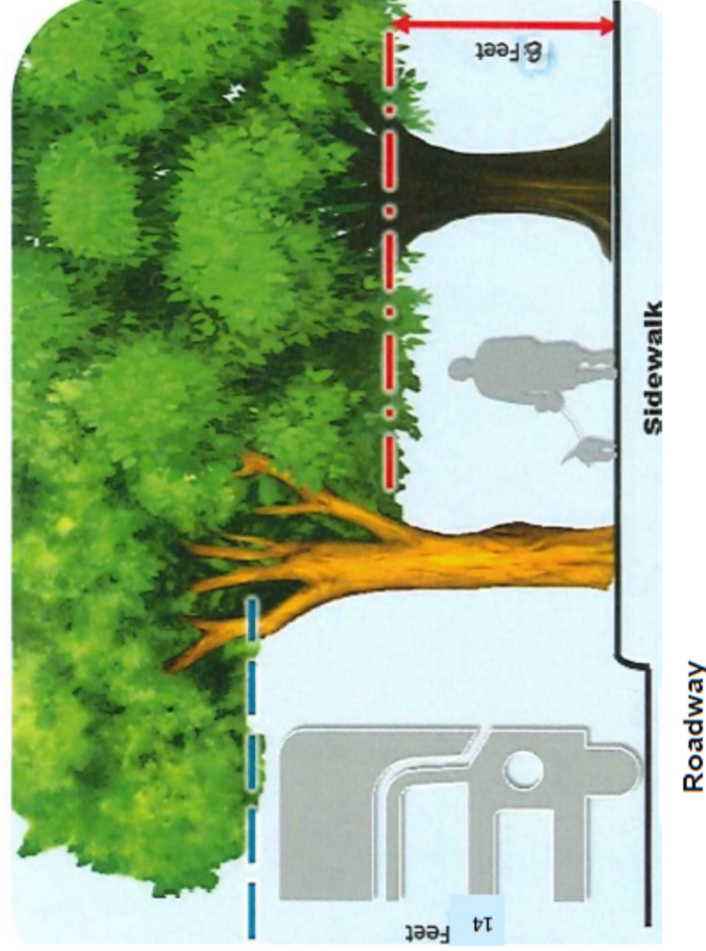
### TREE TRIMMING REMINDERS

Marysville City Code reads:

12-706. Duty to trim trees/bushes on or near public ways.

- (a) It shall be the duty of the owner or agent of real estate in the city abutting upon a public way to keep all trees and bushes located on or adjacent to such real estate property trimmed in a manner that they will not interfere with public travel upon the public way. Any part of a tree or bush projecting over a street or alley that
- (1) Hangs or protrudes less than fourteen (14) feet above street level;
- (2) Interferes with the visibility of any traffic control device or sign;
- or
- (3) Obstructs the light from any streetlight is declared to be hazardous and to interfere with the use of the street or alley.
- (b) Any part of a tree or of a bush projecting over a sidewalk less than eight (8) feet above sidewalk level is declared to be hazardous and to interfere with the use of the sidewalk.
- (c) Any tree or bush located within 35 feet of the curb line of any intersection of the streets in the city is declared to be hazardous unless the lowest branch is trimmed at least fourteen (14) feet and the maximum height of a bush does not exceed 30 inches above the top of the curb nearest the tree or bush unless a member of the Board of Health determines a lower height of the bush is necessary to preclude a traffic or safety hazard.

### Marysville Business Incentives:

- **Incentives Without Walls:** Up to a \$20,000 0% loan for Main Street Members. Contact OneMarysville at 785-562-3101
- **Sidewalk Incentives:** Contact the City Inspector at City Hall 785-562-5331 regarding the Sidewalk Ordinance and incentives and Cost Share Options.
- **Marshall County 0% Revolving 10k Loan Fund:** \$25,000 available for up to \$10,000 loans for new or expanding businesses. Contact Mike Miller with the Partnership for Growth at 402-432-7713.

### Marysville Housing Incentives:

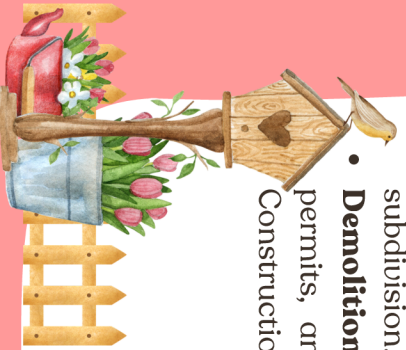
- **Sidewalk Incentive:** Contact the City Inspector at City Hall 785-562-5331 to learn more about the Sidewalk Ordinance and incentives Cost Share Options.
- **Infill Lot Tax Abatement Program:** A 10-year, 100% tax abatement, must increase property value by \$25,000 and must be in a qualifying area. Contact the Marshall County Clerk at 785-562-5361.
- **Neighborhood Revitalization:** Property tax rebate of 60% for 3 years, New construction and rehabilitation of existing structures, Improvements must increase property value by at least \$5000. Contact the Marshall County Clerk at 785-562-5361.

### New Housing Opportunities in Marysville:

- **Homeowner down payment assistance:** Money is the second component of housing. You must have money to buy a home. MCP4G has partnered with pilot program through the North Central Regional Planning Commission to offer a \$10,000 loan at 3% interest for 20 years and a \$2,500 closing grant for eligible borrowers. There are limited quantities available. Application is made through your local bank.
- Additionally, there are several incentives through the Marshall County Neighborhood Revitalization Act and the Marshall County Infill Revitalization program. Contact the Marshall County Clerk at 785-562-5361.

### Economic Development-contact the Marysville City Inspector at 785-562-5331

- **Demolition:** Reimburse up to \$2,500 of demolition cost. Must be in a qualifying subdivision.
- **New Construction:** Reimburse up to \$1,000 of city building permit & construction fees for housing, Must have a minimum appraised value of \$35,000. Must be in a qualifying subdivision.
- **Demolition & New Construction:** Reimburse up to \$5,000 of demolition cost, building permits, and construction fees, Must meet same criteria of Demolition and New Construction.

## BRUSH DUMP

Our city brush dump is open from 9 am until dark 7 days a week.

We do ask that if you are using our dump to please be aware that it is for grass clippings, limbs, tree stumps, etc. We also ask that when you bring these items to the dump that you sort them and place them in the appropriate area for such items. We do not take landscaping items, construction products such as wood, concrete, bricks, etc. or any other household items.

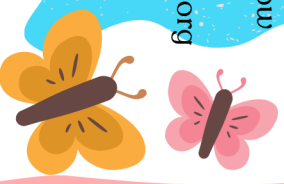
