

SPECIAL MEETING

City of Marysville, Marysville, Kansas, November 30, 2020

Members of the Governing Body of the City of Marysville were called to order in a special meeting at 6:00 p.m., on the date and at the place noted above with Mayor Barnes opening the meeting. City Clerk Holle and City Administrator St. John were also present.

Council members answering present to roll call were: Pippia, Frye, Schroller, Hughes, Beikman, Price, Behrens and Throm. A quorum was present.

The call, signed by seven of eight council members present, read as follows:

We, the undersigned councilmembers of the City of Marysville hereby respectfully request that you call a special council meeting of the members of the governing body of said City to be held at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, November 30, 2020 at City Hall for the following purpose:

Discuss a business proposal from Marshall County Sports and Recreation to provide recreational services in the City of Marysville.

Vincent and Jacey Pacha addressed the Governing Body with a proposal to operate the recreation programs in Marysville. The Council asked how many programs they intend to administer because they only listed 7 in the proposal. The Pachas said they intend to offer all the programs currently in place. They said they intend to run the programs and maintain the fields without contracting out the labor. The Council stated they expect one of them to attend all events. The Pachas will rent an office in Marysville. They said they have read the previously proposed contract and were comfortable with the terms. The contract would be for one year with an option to extend the service. Council asked if they had previous experience running a recreation company. The Pachas said they do not, but Vincent had worked at Bramlage in field preparation.

CM Frye moved to draw up a contract with Vincent and Jacey Pacha to operate the recreation programs in Marysville for one year with the option to extend the contract after negotiations. CM Pippia seconded. Motion passed 7-1. CM Price voted no. CA McNish will review the contract and the contract will be sent to the Pachas.

CM Hughes moved to call a special meeting before the next council meeting if possible, to review the contract with the Pachas, CM Pippia seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

At 6:18 p.m., CM Throm moved, CM Frye seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
