POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

Listed below are those rules deemed necessary to maintain a safe and orderly pool operation. The lifeguards and pool supervisors are responsible for maintaining a safe and orderly facility - **THEIR AUTHORITY MUST BE RESPECTED BY ALL. Lifeguards are on duty for safety & to respond to aquatic emergencies.**

The following is a list of our visitor's policy. They are **GENERAL** in nature and **SHOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED AS A FINAL LIST.**

POOL REGULATIONS

- 1. **ALL** persons entering the pool will pay full admission price unless a season pass or punch card has been purchased or a promotional pass has been issued.
- 2. All persons are required to take a shower before entering pool or pool area.
- 3. **RUNNING, ROUGH PLAY AND PERSONAL CONTACT ENDANGERING SAFETY OF SELF AND OTHERS** in any portion of the establishment shall be prohibited.
- 4. All persons entering the diving area must be able to swim the width of the lap lane and tread water for 2 minutes. (Must be witnessed by guard)
- 5. Use of life saving equipment by authorized personnel only.
- 6. No FOOD OR BEVERAGES in the pool. Consumption of food or beverages is only allowed in the designated concession area.
- 7. No outside food or drink may be brought in unless approved by management.
- 8. No glass items, including suntan oil, will be allowed on the premises.
- 9. Intentional destruction of pool property, including writing on walls, defacing tables and benches, etc. will result in suspension.

- 10. No loitering or horseplay in the bath house.
- 11. Rafts & inner tubes from tires are not permitted in the pool.
- 12. Foreign objects including rocks, towels, etc. are not permitted in the pool. Swimming aids & toys specific for pool play are allowed. (Exceptions are t-shirts being worn to prevent sunburn.)
- 13. Guards are not to visit with patrons while on duty.
- 14. Management is not responsible for loss of any personal belongings.
- 15. CHILDREN AGES 7 AND UNDER must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (14 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER–Subject to the discretion of the manager).
- 16. CHILDREN AGES 6 AND UNDER & those unable to swim must be in direct contact with a parent or guardian 14 years of age or older at all times.
- 17. Loitering on or near the ropes is prohibited.
- 18. Abusive language, obscene gestures, and public displays of affection will not be tolerated.
- 19. All swimmers must wear proper swimming attire. No one shall ride the slides if there is exposed metal or rivets on their swim attire.
- 20. Admission to the pool will be refused to all persons having a communicable disease, open wounds or sores, skin diseases or rashes (unless there is a doctor's note stating it is alright to swim in a public pool).
- 21. In the event of thunder and/or lightning the pool and decks must be cleared immediately and remain clear for 30 minutes after thunder is last heard. No refunds will be made due to inclement weather.
- 22. <u>Slides:</u>
 - a. Must be 48" tall to use large slides.
 - b. Non-swimmers are not permitted to use large slides.
 - c. No flotation devices or goggles may be worn down the slides.

- d. Stay in a single file line on the stairs along the outside of the rail.
- e. Lay down with your arms crossed and feet forward only.
- f. Use only if water is operating.
- g. Swim to nearest ladder or out of landing zone immediately. It is not a play area.
- h. No combs, jewelry, metal or objects allowed in or on pockets during ride.
- 23. Diving Rules:
 - a. No diving from the Lifeguard Stand.
 - b. No diving in the shallow end.
 - c. No back flips off the side of the pool or off the diving boards.
 - d. No flotation devices or goggles may be worn off the diving boards.
 - e. One person on diving board at a time and only one bounce allowed.
 - f. Divers must swim to nearest ladder.
 - g. All persons entering the deep end must be able to swim the width of the lap lane and tread water for 2 minutes. (Must be observed by a guard).
 - h. Children **NOT** able to swim **(See item #7)** may be allowed to jump into the deep end and be caught by a parent <u>with permission</u> from the lifeguard. But ONLY by a parent and when the pool is not crowded.
 - i. Wait until the person is at or past the exit ladders before diving.
 - j. No playing in deep end.
- 24. Toddler Area & Zero Entry Rules:
 - a. Children 6 and under must be in direct contact of an adult or a care provider at least 14 years of age.
 - b. No drinking or eating in the pool.

- c. Walk at all times.
- d. No glass of any kind in the area.
- e. No lawn chairs in the pool.
- f. No disposable diapers. SWIM DIAPERS only. They may be purchased at the concession stand if necessary.
- g. Toddler slide is for ages 2-4 ONLY.
- 25. NO SMOKING THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE FACILITY!!!
- 26. No one under the influence of DRUGS or ALCOHOL is allowed at the pool.
- 27. NO SEXUAL HARRASSMENT will be tolerated. See Policy on page 16.
- 28. DISCIPLINE POLICY:
 - a. 1st Violation: Warning
 - b. 2nd Violation: 15-minute detainment from the pool
 - c. 3rd Violation: Dismissal from pool for one day & parent called.
 - d. 4th Violation: Repeated violations will result in expulsion for a week and ultimately, termination of pool privileges for the season.
- 29. POOL CLOSING POLICY: Pool closing will be determined by the discretion of the Pool Management and the City Administrator.
- 30. LOCKER RULES
 - a. Combination locks are available to purchase at the concession stand.
 - b. Please remove locks at the end of each day.
 - c. Any locks left on the lockers will be cut off at the end of each day.
 - d. Hanging on or slamming locker doors is prohibited.

- e. Patrons, please do not loiter or play near the locker area.
- f. The City of Marysville or pool staff is not responsible for loss of personal belongings.
- 31. Break Policy: 15-minute breaks at 2:30 p.m., 4:15 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Patrons who are 18 years or older may swim during break times. Also, an infant with a parent may swim during break times. One lifeguard will remain on duty during each break time. Other guards will be off duty during break times. All children must sit on the concrete during break times, not in the gutters.
