AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION
14-226 AND 14-227 OF THE 2011 CODE
OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE,
KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 14-226 of the 2011 Code of the City of Marysville, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14-226 SAME; ANNOUNCEMENT. Upon announcement by the chief of police, city administrator or street supervisor that the “Snow Removal Regulations” are in effect, the streets listed in this section shall be designed as “Emergency Snow Routes”. No parking shall be allowed and violating vehicles shall have violations notices placed thereon. Emergency snow route signs shall be posted on the right-hand side of the driving lane at intervals not to exceed four blocks.

- (c) Center – Fourth Street to Twentieth Street

- (h) Spring – Fifteenth Street to Seventeenth Street

- (k) Eleventh Road – North Street to Center (Pony Express Hwy)
- (l) Twelfth Street – Center to Park Place
- (m) Fifteenth Street – North Street to Spring
- (n) Sixteenth Street – Jayhawk Road to North Street
- (o) Seventeenth Street – Spring to Center
- (p) Nineteenth Street – Jenkins to North Street
- (q) Twentieth Street – Center to Airport Administration Building

Section 2. Section 14-227 of the 2011 Code of the City of Marysville, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

14-227 SAME; VEHICLES TO BE REMOVED. Upon accumulation of snow depth of three inches (3”), the “Snow Removal Regulations” are in effect and the following streets shall be designated “Primary Snow Routes” and vehicles are requested to be removed.

- (22) Seventeenth – Spring south to end of Industrial Park
- (23) Eighteenth – Center to Carolina
- (24) Eighteenth – Jenkins to North Street
